With a dedicated focus on Endocrinology, particularly diabetes, I have consistently pursued advancements in this field. My primary area of expertise lies in diabetes neuropathy, where I delve into peripheral manifestations such as neuropathic pain and diabetic foot ulcers. In 2022, I successfully defended my PhD thesis, centered around early detection, grading, and prevention of small fiber neuropathy. Building upon this foundation, I've continued my research endeavors part-time, initially as a post-doctoral fellow, and as of 2024, as an associate professor at Aalborg University. Concurrently, I am committed to furthering my specialization in endocrinology.
